Maybe that hero is YOU!



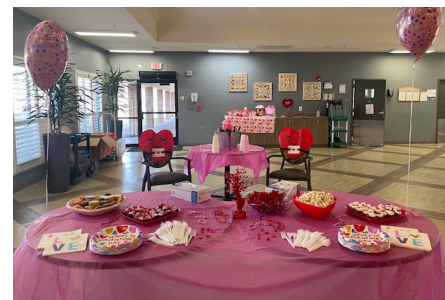

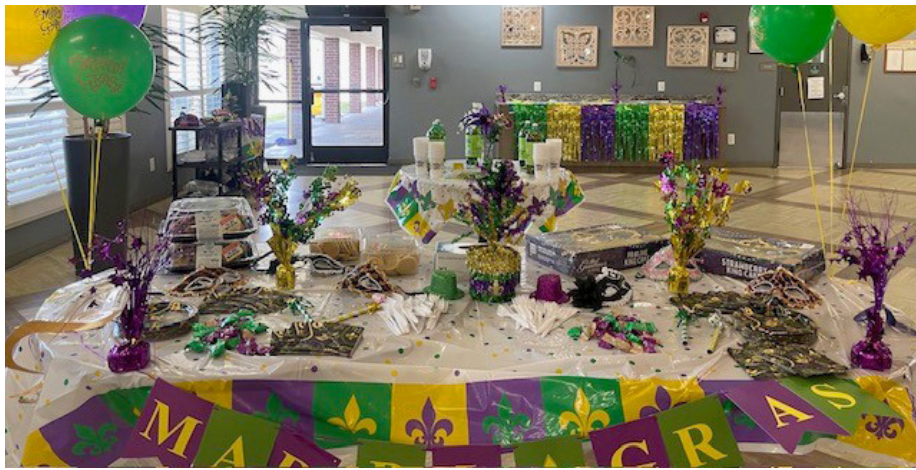
